### **Supply, Installation and Commissioning of a Drive Test Solution in order to test and benchmark the performance and Quality of Service of the telecommunication service providers for voice, data and video services.**

1. This invitation for bids follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in Development Business, issue no. 605 of April 30, 2003.
2. The People’s Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of the Telecommunications Technical Assistance Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for the Purchase of its Drive Test Solution in order to test and benchmark the performance and Quality of Service of the telecommunication service providers for voice, data and video services.
3. The Bangladesh Telecommunications Regulatory Commission (BTRC) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Drive Test Solution in order to test and benchmark the performance and Quality of Service of the telecommunication service providers for voice, data and video services.
4. Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive bidding procedures specified in the World Bank’s Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits published by the Bank in January 1995 and revised in January and August 1996, September 1997 and January 1999, and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from BTRC and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. in

working days. The documents will also be available in BTRC website: [www.btrc.gov.bd](http://www.btrc.gov.bd) for information only.

6. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Tk. 3,500.00 (Taka Three thousand and Five hundred) or in US \$50.00 (US\$ Fifty.) The method of payment will be by bank draft/pay order in favor of Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission on any scheduled bank in Bangladesh. The document will be delivered by hand to an accredited agent of the bidder or sent by courier. For delivery by courier additional US\$ 50.00 or Taka 3,500.00 to be paid as above.
7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 2:00 p.m. on August 02, 2009. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of **not less than** 2% of the bid value in local currency or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency. The method of payment will be by bank draft/pay order in favor of Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission on any scheduled bank in Bangladesh. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below immediately after closing of the reception of the bids. <sup>11</sup>
